Subject: Selection Trials for Elite Track Cyclists

Dear Sir/Madam,

Greetings from Cycling Federation of India!

As per the Selection Policy published by Cycling Federation of India in consonance with the guidelines of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, the Selection Trials for Elite Men & Women will be conducted at 09:00 AM on 24th & 25th July 2026 at Cycling Velodrome, NSNIS Patiala.

The trials are being conducted to prepare a long list for various International Track Cycling events scheduled up to December 2026. A copy of the Selection Policy is enclosed herewith for reference.

The trials will be held for the following events:

S. No. Elite Men/Women Events

- 1 1000 Mtrs. Time Trial
- 2 200 Mtrs. Sprint
- 3 250 Mtrs. & 500 Mtrs. Time Trial for Team Sprint
- 4 4 Km. Individual Pursuit
- 5 25 Km. Point Race (Men) & 20 Km. Point Race (Women)

Only Elite Men and Elite Women riders shall be eligible to participate in the Selection Trials.

Cyclists who had secured up to 8th rank in the National Track Cycling Championships 2024 shall be eligible to participate in the trials. Riders not falling under the above eligibility criteria may also participate by depositing an entry fee of Rs. 2,000/-, which shall be refundable if the rider secures a position within the top

6 in the respective event during the trials.

Random dope testing may be conducted during the Selection Trials.

Kindly note that no boarding and lodging facilities will be provided by the Federation during the trials. However, breakfast and lunch shall be provided on both days of the Selection Trials.

All State Associations/UTs/Boards are requested to submit the entries of eligible riders through their respective State Associations latest by 12th July 2026. No entries shall be entertained after the stipulated deadline under any circumstances.
