1st NATIONAL PARA CYCLING ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP, 2025

Technical Guide – 1st National Para Cycling Road Championships, 2025

- 1. Introduction:** Paralympic Committee of India (PCI) and Cycling Federation of India (CFI) welcomes all the participants and officials for the 1st National Para Cycling Road Championships 2025.
 - 1.1 The 1st National Para Cycling Road Championship, 2025 is being hosted by the Telangana Cycling Association under the aegis of the Cycling Federation of India (CFI). The technical support will be provided by the Paralympic Committee of India (PCI). The competition will be conducted as per UCI Rules & Regulations.
 - 1.2 The Competition will be held at Hyderabad on 29th -30th March, 2025.
 - 29 March 2025, 10am onwards: Classification
 - Slot will be given based on timing.
 - Athletes to report with necessary documents
 - Medical disability certificate
 - Medical reports of Disability
 - Medical Diagnostic Form
 - Cycle, helmet, cycling shoes and any assistive device which they use during cycling.
 - 29 March 2025, 4pm : Team Manager Meeting
 - 30 March 2025, 7am onwards : Individual Time Trial competition
 - 1.3 All races will be conducted together as per category wise (C1 - C5). However, the final timings will be considered as per category wise and results will be declared. A State/U.T./Team can enter in one age group and in one disability class. A cyclist can only take part in his own age-group and in one event. Entries should originally be received for the event to be viable for conducting. However, in case of lesser entries, the event may be combined with other higher category/class events to make it viable and results will be declared as per UCI rules (factor wise). The Technical Committee, CFI reserves the right to make any change/s in the programme, if necessary, for administrative convenience. The decision of the Technical Committee in all matters pertaining to competition shall be final and binding.
 - 1.4 The Cyclists should carry their Para Cycling Riding license, which can be received from the CFI affiliated State / UT units after Registration, and produce for license check at the time of entry confirmation during Managers Meeting.
 - 1.5 The entry of the Cyclists should have been received through the CFI affiliated State/U.T. Units and CFI Affiliated Member Federations by 15th March, 2025 together with all required medical documentations.

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2. Championship Details:

Venue	: Hyderabad
Classification Date	: 29 th March, 2025
Race / Event Date	: 30 th March, 2025
Race Format	: Individual Time Trial
Race Distance	: 13 KMs (may vary depending on road)

Team Managers Meeting will be held on 29th March 2025 at 4.00PM. The event communique will be published in advance. All team managers and athletes are required to attend. It is the responsibility of the teams/athlete to be familiar with the event rules and regulations.

3. Rules of competition:

- Rules will be those of Cycling Federation of India (CFI) and Virtus Sivus India, which are based on the rules of Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).
- All athletes are required to purchase personal insurance.
- There will be no upper age limit for athletes to participate.
- Competition will be held separately for Junior & Senior Wings only.
- Competition will be held separately for both Men & Women.

4. Eligible Categories:-

- C1 - C5 : Athletes with class C riding bicycle
- H1 - H5 : Athletes with class H riding handcycle
- T1 - T5 : Athletes with class T riding Trike bike
- CII 1 : Athletes with Intellectual Impairment

5. Classifications:

- 5.1 **Athletes with Physical Impairment** competing in the National Championships will have their category determined by both Medical and Technical classifiers.
- a. Any athletes not previously classified or listed on the UCI Master List must attend a classification session on 29th March, 2025 at Aditya Mehta Foundation at 9, Mahatma Gandhi Rd, Hyderbasthi, Rani Gunj, Secunderabad, Telangana 500003.
 - b. Medical classification will be conducted by Dr. Asha Shaikh, and technical classification by Mr. Aditya Mehta.
 - c. Participants are required to submit the Medical Diagnostics Form (MDF) along with relevant medical documents by 20th March, 2025 positively to cyclingfederationofindia@gmail.com, paracyclingindia@gmail.com. More information on UCI's classification process & guidelines can be found on UCI website.
 - d. For Classification, the cyclists should bring:
 - i) Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) typed-filled, signed and sealed by the Doctor.
 - ii) Cycling Riding License, which can be applied through State/UT associations
 - iii) Original Aadhar Card,
 - iv) Original Date of Birth Certificate, and
 - v) Disability Certificate as issued by the Govt. Authorities.

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5.2 **Athletes with Intellectual Impairment (Category CII 1):** - should be certified by Virtus-World Intellectual Impairment Sport (earlier known as INAS) and produce a certificate from Virtus Sivus India (affiliated Indian body to Virtus) at the time of classification that the athlete belongs to CII 1 Class. Strict adherence to Virtus Eligibility Guidelines and Criteria is required for participation.

- a. All cyclists must be pre-approved by Virtus Sivus India and registered with the Cycling Federation of India (CFI). Applications for new cyclists should be submitted to Virtus Sivus India by 20th March, 2025. Athletes not approved by Sivus India are not ineligible to compete.

6. Equipment:

- Bring along the bike and required gears for bike check. Bike check(s) will be conducted in the staging area on Race Day for all categories. All athletes are fully responsible for arriving 30 minutes ahead of the race time for these checks. Bike check will follow the rules as per given in UCI Regulations.
- Hydration / Water bottles must be secured properly.
- A helmet is mandatory and must be worn at all times from the point of race start to finish.
- Any electrical systems such as Radio devices, iPods, earpieces / earphones, cameras etc are not permitted during the race.

7. Medal Events:

- Top 3 athletes will be presented with medals per category. Medal events will be combined in the event of less athletes in category and the committee will finalize & communicate this before the event.
- National Champion Jerseys will be awarded to the gold medalists.
- Participation Certificates will be provided to athletes who finish the race.

8. **Accommodation:** Athletes and teams have to arrange their own accommodation. LOC will suggest the nearest hotels/accommodation options nearer to event location.

9. **Transportation:** Athletes and teams have to arrange their own transportation to and from the trials venue. Please make sure to arrange in advance to avoid any inconvenience.

10. **Decision & Protest Rules:** The decision of the Technical committee shall be final and binding to all. For any disputes or complaints, athletes must present their concerns to the Protest Committee on race day. It is the athlete's responsibility to resolve the matter with the Protest Committee on the same day; no issues will be considered after the event has concluded. The Protest Committee's decision is final and must be accepted by the athlete.

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12. IMPORTANT / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- a. Attending Medical Classification by all newly entrant Cyclists is compulsory.
- b. Athletes / teams found guilty of manipulating the age and / or percentage of disability shall be debarred from participation in the National Championship for one year or more.
- c. No Athlete/official/coach/manager/parent shall go/speak to the Print or Electronic Media without prior and proper prior permission from CFI.
- d. Personal photography at the Competition site shall be permitted only under written permission from CFI and of those individuals who are involved in the photograph/video.
