As per the decision taken in the AGM of Cycling Federation of India held in June 2022, the following regulations shall be implemented in the forthcoming National Championships: -

National Road Cycling Championships

1. In sub junior age group (Boys & Girls under 16 years), it has been decided to make the following changes:-
 - a. A Team Time Trial event has been included in the sub-junior age group (boys & girls) from 27th National Road Championships onward.
 - b. At the start of the sub-junior category race, a TTT team will consist of three riders and the second rider's final time will be considered as team's time.
 - c. In the sub-junior age group, the Team Time Trial event will have a distance of 25 Km. for boys and 20 Km. for Girls, however, the distance shall be changed depending upon the Road condition.
2. In Youth category (boys & girls between 12 to 14 years), it has been decided to make the following changes:-
 - a. A Team Time Trial event has been included in the youth age group (boys & girls) from upcoming National Road Championships.
 - b. At the start of the youth category race, a TTT team will consist of three riders and the second rider's time will be considered as team's time.
 - c. If a team does not have three riders at the start of the TTT event, the team may start with two riders, but the race must be completed by both the riders and the time of second rider will be considered as team's time.
 - d. Distance of the TTT event will be 20 Km. for boys and 15 Km. for girls, however, the distance shall be changed depending upon the road condition.
3. In youth category, there will be a total of **4 boys & 4 girls** in a team.
4. The Team Time Trial event in Men and Women Elite categories is being abolished from the upcoming National Championships.
 - a. In place of Team Time Trial event, A mixed team relay has been introduced in the Elite category from the upcoming National Championships (27th NRCC).
 - b. In the men elite and women elite age groups, the distance of the mixed relay event will be 20 to 25 Km. each for both men and women respectively.
 - c. In the mixed Team relay, 3 riders of the men's team are mandatory to start the race. Men's teams will be given start first for the race.
 - d. The women's team will be given the start once the second rider of men's team finishes the race.

5. Madison event will be included in the National Track Cycling Championships for Men Elite Category.

General Guidelines: -

6. Some riders from Services Sports Control Board, Railway Sports Promotion Board and other affiliated Boards to CFI, participate in National Championships (Road, Track & MTB) from time to time, from other State Cycling Associations.

From this year, such riders will be able to participate in National Championships with the following guidelines:-

- a. Before participating from another state, such riders have to obtain NOC from the Board they belong to.
- b. They will be eligible to participate in Team events only, however, 50% of the riders must belong to the respective state.
- c. Only 2 such riders are eligible to participate from their respective state.
- d. This is applicable only for riders from the Boards (BSNL, SSCB, RSPB, AIPSCB, Punjab Police etc.)
- e. He/she is either domicile of the state, they wish to represent
Or he/ she is serving in the state they wish to represent.
- f. It is mandatory from the riders to have participated and qualified in the state trials, from where they wish to participate.
