

Minutes of the Selection Committee Meeting

Selection of the Indian Para Cycling Team for the Asian Para Games 2026

Date: 16th July 2026

Mode: Online

A meeting of the Selection Committee was held online on **16th July 2026** to select the **Indian Para Cycling Team** for participation in the forthcoming **Asian Para Games 2026**.

The following members were present:

1. **Mr. V. N. Singh** – Director (Administration), CFI as Chairman
2. **Mr. Manish Rana** – Director, Performance, PCI as Member
3. **Mr. Gurlal Singh** – Sportsperson of Outstanding Merit (Asian Games Medallist in Para Cycling)
4. **Ms. Jyoti Radheshyam Gaderiya** – Imminent Sportsperson (Paralympian in Cycling)

Proceedings

At the outset, **Mr. V. N. Singh**, Representative of the Cycling Federation of India, welcomed all the members and informed the Committee that, based on the **UCI Para Cycling Asian Rankings up to December 2025**, India has secured **seven (7) quota places** for the **Asian Para Games 2026**, comprising **four (4) quota places in the Men's category** and **three (3) quota places in the Women's category**.

He further presented the latest Asian rankings of the eligible Indian para cyclists before the Committee for its consideration. The Committee deliberated on the rankings, eligibility, performance records and the available quota places in accordance with the selection policy and unanimously resolved to select the following athletes and officials to represent India at the forthcoming **Asian Para Games 2026**.

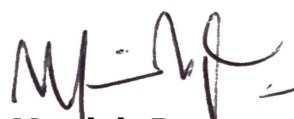

There being no other item on the agenda, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.



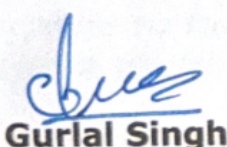

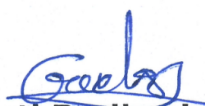
