Agenda 3: Audited accounts of Cycling Federation of India for the year 2023-24

Sh. Maninder Pal Singh, Secretary General, Cycling Federation of India (CFI), requested **Sh. Vimal Chaudhary**, Treasurer, CFI, to present the accounts before the house.

Agenda 4: To approve the National Calendar for the year 2025-26.

Maninder Pal Singh, Secretary General, Cycling Federation of India (CFI), informed the house that the **Management Committee of the CFI**, in its meeting held on **24th December 2024** at New Delhi, had finalized the allotment of the **National Championships for the year 2025-26**. The proposed allotments were placed before the house for approval, as follows:

- **MTB National Championship** – Arunachal Pradesh Cycling Association

Maninder Pal Singh proposed that the appreciation of the house be formally recorded for **Adv. M. K. Pasha**, who developed the ranking system **voluntarily and free of cost**.

Subsequently, **Adv. M. K. Pasha** was invited to present the names of the **best-ranked athletes for the year**, details of which were **enclosed as Annexure - II**. Adv. Pasha expressed his gratitude to the Secretary General for the opportunity to contribute to the Federation.

Sh. Ajit Singh, Chairman of the Commissaire Selection & Training Commission, proposed the introduction of a **new licensing system** for the Cycling Federation of India, effective **1st April 2025**. He explained the structure and operation of the proposed system to the members.

After discussion, the house **unanimously approved the implementation** of the new licensing system.

Sh. Maninder Pal Singh further informed the house that beginning in **2024**, the Cycling Federation of India had launched a new initiative to introduce the **CFI Level 1 Coaching Course**. The **first edition** of this course was conducted **online**, and successful participants were awarded **certificates and coaching licenses**. This **new coaching license is distinct from the existing licenses** and is granted **only to those who pass the CFI Level 1 Coaching Course**.

The house **highly appreciated** this initiative taken by the Federation for the **development of certified coaches** across the country.
