

Regulation for Selection Trials / State Championships

These regulations govern the procedures and documentation required after the completion of State Selection Trials or State Championships conducted by State Cycling Associations, in case CFI fails to appoint a PCP for any reason whatsoever. The purpose is to ensure transparency, standardization, and compliance with CFI guidelines as follows:-

- 1) State Association must submit a complete report of the selection trials/state championships to CFI.
- 2) The state can appoint a PCP provided the Commissaire is an accredited/ licensed and do competent to carry out such duties, which may include commissaire course, certification from CFI etc.
- 3) Detailed results of all events must be submitted duly signed by the PCP.
- 4) The Results must be signed by the PCP and in addition countersigned by the President/Secretary/ Authorised representative of the State Association.
- 5) Submit all technical documents such as timing sheets, race protocols, lap sheets, and attendance sheets as applicable.
- 6) Any penalties or disqualifications during the event must be reported.
- 7) CFI may ask for additional documents if needed.
- 8) CFI shall accept and approve results only after verifying all submitted documents.
