- Devise a plan to upskill domestic coaches; ensure these coaches get sufficient opportunity to learn and develop from the high-performance team.
- Develop and implement a soft skill curriculum for a more holistic development of athletes and coaches.
- Oversee the implementation of athlete monitoring/management and relevant technology systems in Cycling.

- Serve as an advisory in the formation of sport specific developmental policies, including anti-doping.
- Fulfil other relevant roles and responsibilities as designated by competent authorities from time to time.
