Addendum to the Selection Policy

Cycling Federation of India

To enhance transparency and performance-based selection for the Internation events, the following addendum be added in the existing guidelines of selection policy:

- 1. The selection trails are based only for the full-fledged teams participating in continental Championships/ Asian Games/ Commonwealth Games. However, these riders, who are already in the World Ranking, will be participating in other UCI class I & UCI Class II events just to gain points and to improve their World Ranking. The Selection trials will not be the criteria for such events, but only the World UCI ranking will be the sole criteria.
- 2. The Bi-annual selection trials are only for the purpose of long list for the riders to be trained at the NCOEs for the preparation of various International events.

3. Training Phases:

Riders identified as potential candidates must undergo various stages of **technical and tactical training** designed to improve their skill levels. These training phases aim to prepare athletes for qualification in **major international cycling events**.

4. Participation in UCI Events:

Based on the assessment of the **Chief Coach** in consultation with the **Selection Committee** selected potential cyclists shall be trained and prepared to participate in **UCI Class I and Class II events**. The goal is to earn **UCI ranking points**, thereby enhancing their global rankings, which are critical for qualifying in major international competitions.

5. Qualification Based on UCI Rankings:

Riders who have achieved a **TOP UCI ranking** shall be given priority and encouraged to participate in **UCI point-scoring events**. This strategy will further support their progression and qualification for **mega cycling events** such as World Championships, Nations Cup, Asian Games, Commonwealth Games and the Olympics etc.
